

### 3. WRISTBAND POLICY

Safety and liability are always major concerns. In order to **protect our guests and Park assets**, we need to verify that all guests in the Park are authorized to be here and have paid the appropriate fees. This goal is accomplished by requiring our guests to **register with the office and wear wristbands**.

We have tried to make registration simple and straightforward. Our policy is to issue removable wristbands to the site occupant and their immediate family (who are at the Park regularly). Other family members and guests will be issued temporary wristbands upon request.

An "Official Ticket" will be issued for failure to follow this policy (Refer to Appendix B "Jellystone Park™ of Fort Atkinson "Official Ticket"").

State law for campgrounds requires that the office maintains records of all those that are at the campground at any given time.

- 3.1 Site owners and seasonals must **register annually** with the office. (Refer to Appendix C, "Wristband and Car Registration Form").
- 3.2 Only **immediate family** members that come up all the time will receive **removable wristbands**. Immediate family is defined as parents (up to 2) and their children. You must indicate on the form those that should receive a removable wristband by putting a star next to their name (**up to 6 people**, unless approved otherwise by Park Manager). These wristbands are only for person intended and are **not transferrable**.

3.3 **Other immediate family** members and guests added to the registration form will get **temporary wristbands** when they visit. The wristbands are free provided there are six (6) or less guests per site for that particular day/weekend. Normal day pass fees are charged for additional guests. Guest wristbands are to be used for those intended and not transferable. Guests that do not plan on spending the night must leave before quiet time. Vehicle passes must be purchased by all guests (Refer to Appendix J, "Fee Schedule")

- 3.4 There are **three (3) wristband categories** as designated by color. The colors will vary every year to prevent misuse.
  - **21 & over.** To identify those of legal drinking age and eliminate underage drinking.
  - **Licensed drivers** (state or Yogi) **under the age of 21.** To identify those that are not of legal drinking age, but are permitted to drive golf carts per golf cart policy. (Refer to Section 5 "Golf Cart Registration & Use Policy")
  - **Children and unlicensed persons under the age of 21.**

3.5 There is a **charge to replace a removable wristband**. It is your responsibility to take care of your wristband. The office will replace a worn or damaged wristband free of charge if you return the old band. We will keep track of wristband issuance electronically.

3.6 **Wristbands must be worn on your wrist and visible** at all times while in the Park. You are responsible for compliance by your guests as well. If you (or your guest) are found in violation, an "Official Ticket" will be issued. Arguing over a ticket or excuses will not be tolerated. The office will

keep track of your tickets and an invoice for any fines will be added to your account and sent to you.

- 3.7 Old wristbands** should be discarded. Using, or giving others to use, last years wristbands will be construed as trying to beat the system and result in an “Official Ticket” being issued.

## 4. CAR PASS and USE POLICY

Safety and liability are always major concerns. In order to **protect our guests and Park assets**, we need to verify that all vehicles in the Park are authorized to be here and have paid the appropriate fees. This goal is accomplished by requiring our guests to **register with the office and display a Jellystone Park™ car pass or decal**. Your site number will be on the car pass/decal so we know that you are parked at the appropriate site.

- 4.1** Site owners and seasonals must **register annually** with the office. (Refer to Appendix C, “Wristband and Car Registration Form”). We must have complete vehicle information, year, make and model, color, license plate number, on all vehicles that will have the decal or car tag in order to issue a car decal/pass. If you change vehicles or buy a new vehicle, be sure to update the information on your record at the lodge.
- 4.2** **Only 2 car passes or decals** will be issued per site. You will have a choice between window decals or car tags that hang from your car’s rear-view mirror. You may request either type or a combination of the two.
- The decals are designed for people who will always be driving the same vehicle to the Park and don’t want the bother of tracking a mirror tag.
  - Mirror tags are for those people who have multiple vehicles and aren’t sure which vehicle will be used. The mirror tags allow you to easily move the tag from one vehicle to another. The mirror tag will have a registration number on it and any vehicle that uses it must be registered with the Park.

- 4.3 Do not park on someone else's lot** unless you have obtained written permission. A copy of this permission must on file in the office in order to get an additional car pass/decal. We will issue you the car pass or decal with that lot number on it. Parking on someone else's site is still subject to the two cars per site limit.
- 4.4** Your guests will be required to purchase a daily car pass and should park on your site.
- 4.5** When available you may **purchase an additional season car pass** for a fee that allows you to park in a spot designated by Park management. You also have the option to purchase a daily car pass, similarly to your guests, to park a third vehicle on your lot.
- 4.6** All vehicles must be **driven over**, not around, **speed bumps**. **All tires** must go over the speed bump. Drive over speed bumps at a safe speed for you, your passengers and the vehicle. Do not drive around a speed bump in order to make way for advancing vehicles (including tractor); stop on side of road and wait for traffic to pass by.
